

Buttplate, brass or nickel silver#BP-E-4-B or S

An early Plains rifle buttplate, for a fullstock or halfstock percussion rifle with a large butt. Such a rifle would often have a brass or silver patchbox or capbox.

- #BP-E-4-B sand cast yellow brass **only \$14.50**
- #BP-E-4-S sand cast nickel silver **only \$15.50**

Buttplate, brass or nickel silver#BP-E-6-B or S

A medium size buttplate for a halfstock percussion Plains rifle, such as those made by H. E. Dimick of St. Louis, or by Wurflein of Philadelphia. Consider adding a small brass or silver capbox, with round or oval lid.

- #BP-E-6-B sand cast yellow brass **only \$14.50**
- #BP-E-6-S sand cast nickel silver **only \$15.50**

Buttplate, brass or nickel silver#BP-E-8-B or S

This nicely shaped Littlestown or York County buttplate is sand cast in yellow brass, or nickel silver.

- #BP-E-8-B sand cast yellow brass **only \$14.50**
- #BP-E-8-S sand cast nickel silver **only \$15.50**
